HOW TO PLAN FUN FOR CHILDREN.

When planning our activities, I first look at the month, then the weeks, then the days. Planning backwards is the easiest way to fill your time slots with fun and entertaining activities.

To do this you will need to get out this Kids Activity Planner. Your personal planner will also be needed as well as a school planner and any other activities you may be involved in.

Using your brainstorming page sit and ask yourself these questions:

- Do you see any upcoming celebrations or holidays? You can plan a fun week leading up to a holiday or birthday.
- What time of year is it? Spring, Summer, Fall or Winter? Use the seasons for planning activities.
- What would my child love to do? If you don't know, ask them they will tell you.
- What are my kids learning at school or home? Could I reinforce it with fun hands-on games or activities?

Once your brainstorming page is finished you can start to plan. I would start simple and work my way to more activities. Keep a running list of supplies needed for each day

Monthly Planning: I usually choose a weekly theme for my kids and include crafts, books, lessons and role-playing fun. You could also choose a monthly theme or no theme at all.

Weekly Planning: After your monthly ideas are picked then go to your weekly plan. In the beginning try planning 5 days or less, leaving your weekend open to relax and prepare for the next week. Don't have time during the week? Plan the weekends instead!

Daily Planning: Your daily activities will need to work around you and your child's schedule. Try for one small activity a day such as painting or playdoh while you cook dinner. Reading a book before bed or just sit and play with you child. All of these activities could be theme related.
